**SCHOOL BOARD SPOTLIGHT-Stan Martin Bio.** I grew up in Illinois and Colorado. I went to Adventist Elementary school, High School and College before coming to North Carolina State University for graduate school. I have many fond memories of various teachers I came in contact with throughout my undergraduate education. Together they helped shape my world view, and prepared me for a professional career in life sciences, specializing in structural biology and Genomics. I very much appreciate the strong education that I received at both the K-12 and college level from the Adventist schools; I feel they did a fantastic job preparing me for my life's work of understanding our genetic makeup. I have had the privilege of talking one on one with many prominent scientists, such as Dr. James Watson co-discoverer of DNA, Francis Collins, head of the publicly funded Human Genome Project, and author of the book "The Language of God", which explores the relationship between scientific discovery and faith. It is amazing to me how with each new discovery, scientists get closer and closer to figuring out what theologians have known for centuries.

I firmly believe in the value that our school provides by teaching the Biblical view of world origins. This is a unique perspective that is simply not taught in other schools, even other Christian schools. It opens the minds eye, and makes one receptive to alternative ideas, that other more traditionally educated scientists often miss. This has led to several very significant breakthroughs in medicine. I truly believe that the education our school system offers is the best available anywhere in the world, and feel richly blessed to have the privilege of sending my children to our local church school.

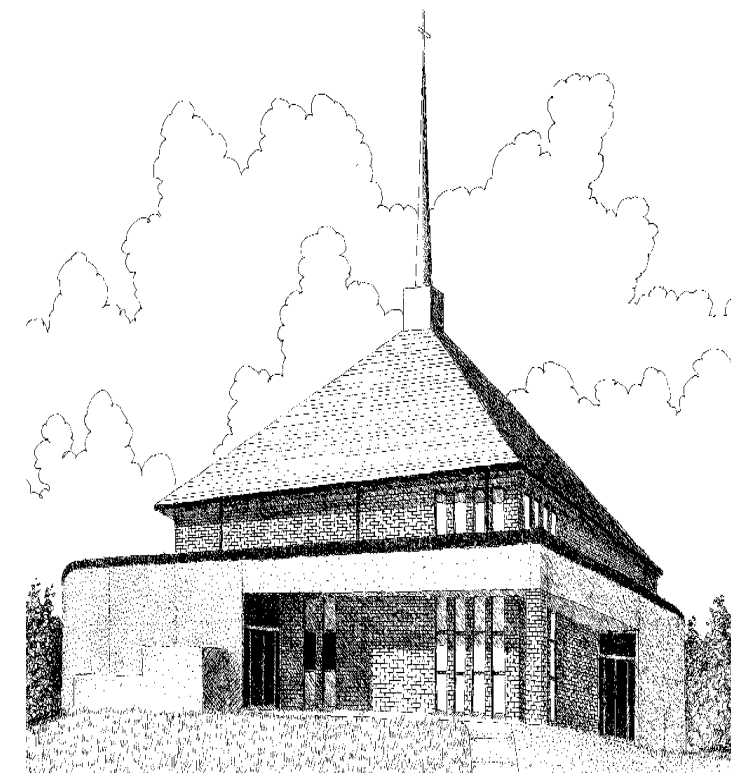
ACA will be closed to students and staff October 15 through 17 for teacher convention at Nosoca Pines. Classes will resume October 18. Please mark your calendars!
