A recent Valuegenesis survey indicates the importance of unified, cooperative support between the school, the home and the church families. The results are startling.

If a student is a Seventh Day Adventist with no support---he has only a 22% chance of remaining intimately connected to Jesus!

If the student has one area of support (home or school or church)---he has a 36% probability of maintaining a close, intimate connection with Christ.

Parent/Teacher conference appointments have been set for Sunday, October 21 beginning at 10:00 am.

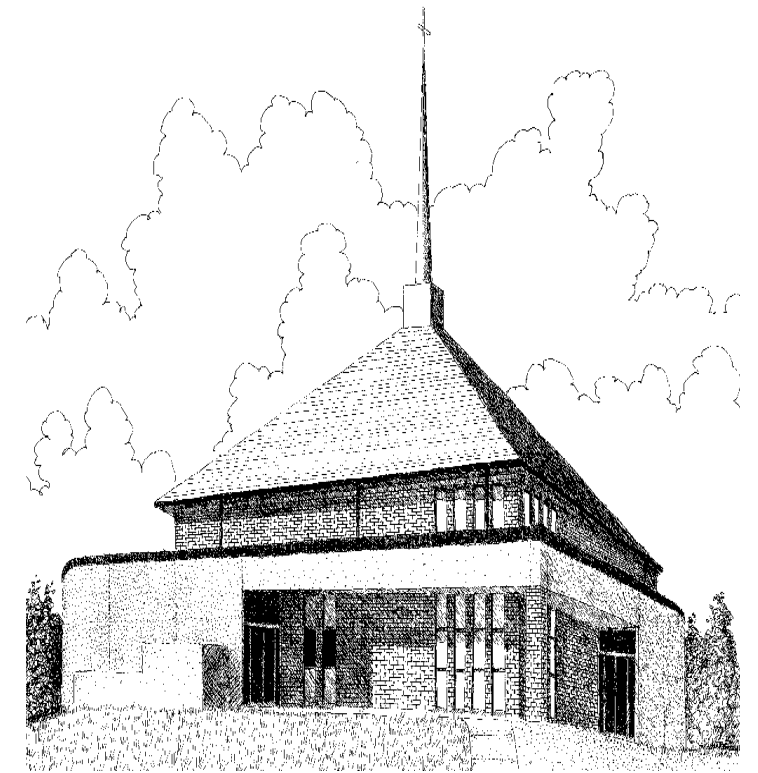
