Special thanks to Janice and Maddie Castle for the beautiful yardwork you did for the school this week. Thanks for your help and support! The grounds look wonderful!

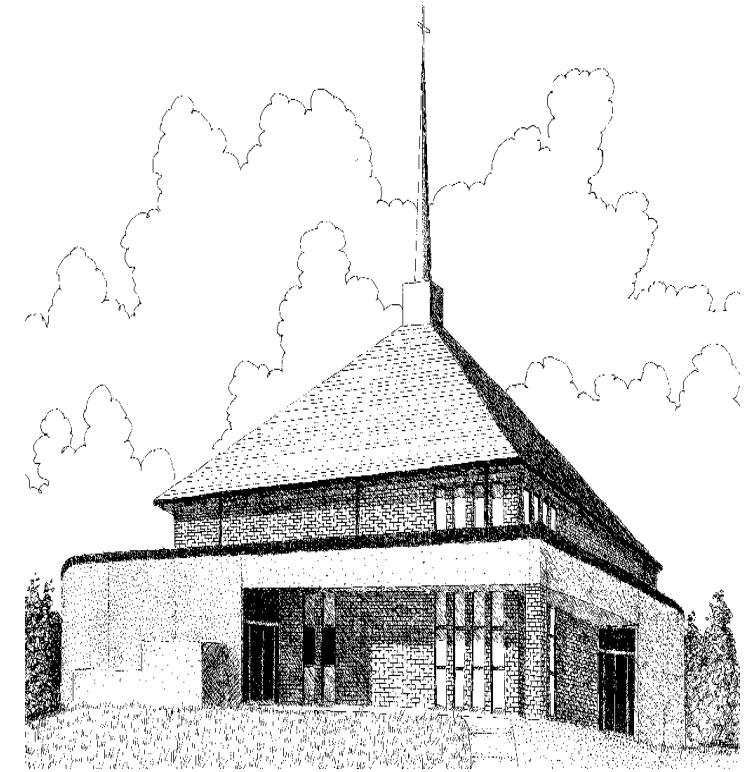
