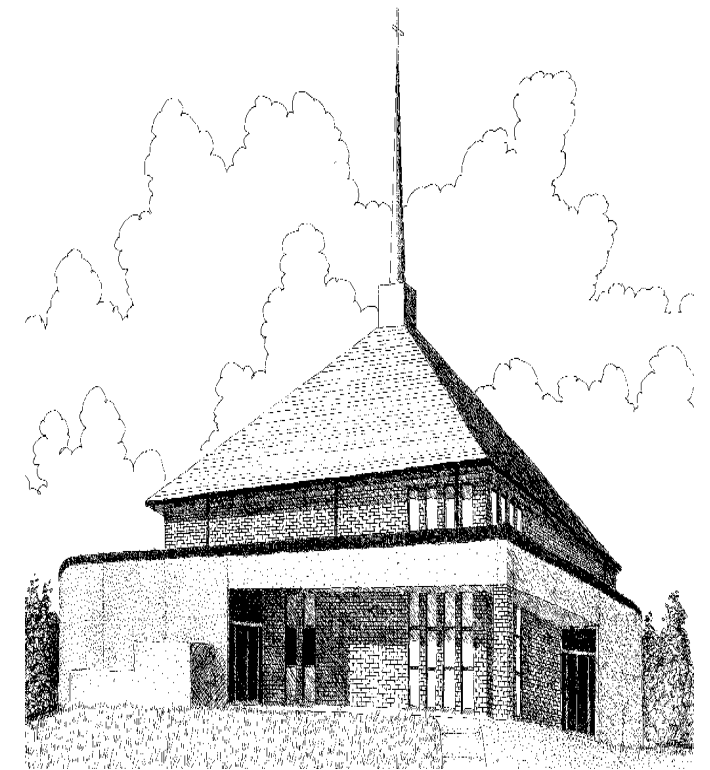
Graduation is May 15! Join us as we celebrate the accomplishments of our students.
