ACA Alumni: Where Are They Now?--OUR ACA ALUMNI REPORT. Our featured June ACA Raleigh alumnus is Thiago Costa. We at ACA Raleigh are pleased to share Thiago's story and his update with our church family. Thiago has often shared many of his talents with us as we have worshipped together. He has served our family at the piano and in the pulpit. Here is his story:

Thiago was born in Tucson, Arizona Nov 12, 1987, where His family lived until he was about 1 yr old. Thiago's father, Sergio, works for IBM which sent the family on international assignments to different countries during Thiago's childhood.

When Thiago was 1 yr old his family returned to Brazil. Next, the family came to Raleigh where Thiago attended K4/K5. At the close of Thiago's K5 year, the family once again returned to Brazil. There Thiago attended 1st and 2nd grades at a large SDA school of approximately 1000 students in Campinas, San Paulo.

Work assignments then moved the family to Bonn, Germany, where Thiago attended 3rd and 4th grades at a US Department of Defense School. English was the first language used to teach the students at the Defense school. Thiago learned to understand German from watching television and speaking with neighbors.

The next assignment brought the family back to Raleigh where Thiago attended public school for 5th and 6th grades. Thiago remained in Raleigh for his middle and high school years. In Raleigh, he attended grades 7-9 at the Adventist Christian Academy of Raleigh.

Thiago completed his 10th-12th grades at Cary High School, where he graduated in 2006.

He started college at Southern Adventist University as a biochemistry major but decided that he wanted to study dentistry. In the fall of 2007, Thiago made the decision to go to University of Monte Morelos in Mexico, where he has just completed finishing his freshman year. He will graduate as a Dentist in 2011 and then he'll need to take 2 additional years in the US, if he decides to practice dentistry here.

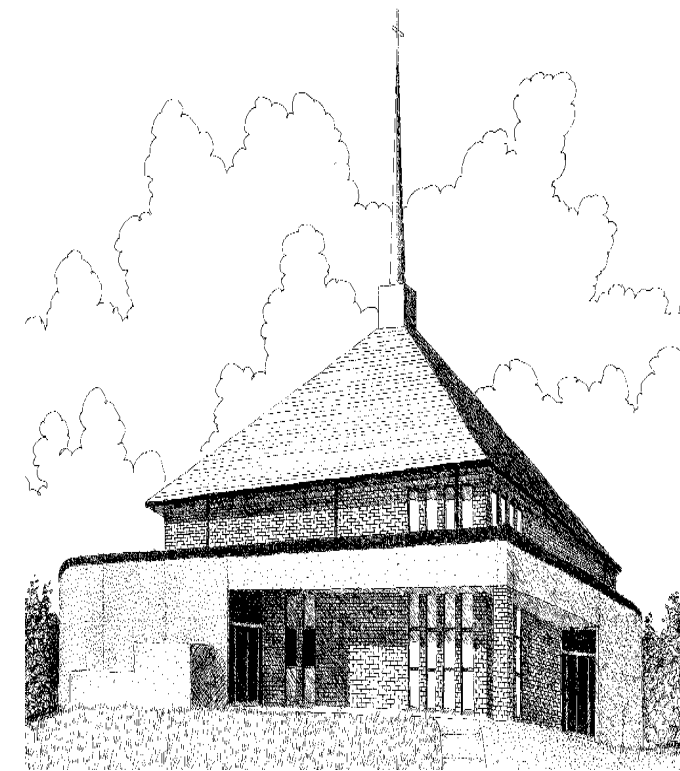
Thiago can now speak, read and write fluently in 3 languages: English, Portuguese and Spanish.
