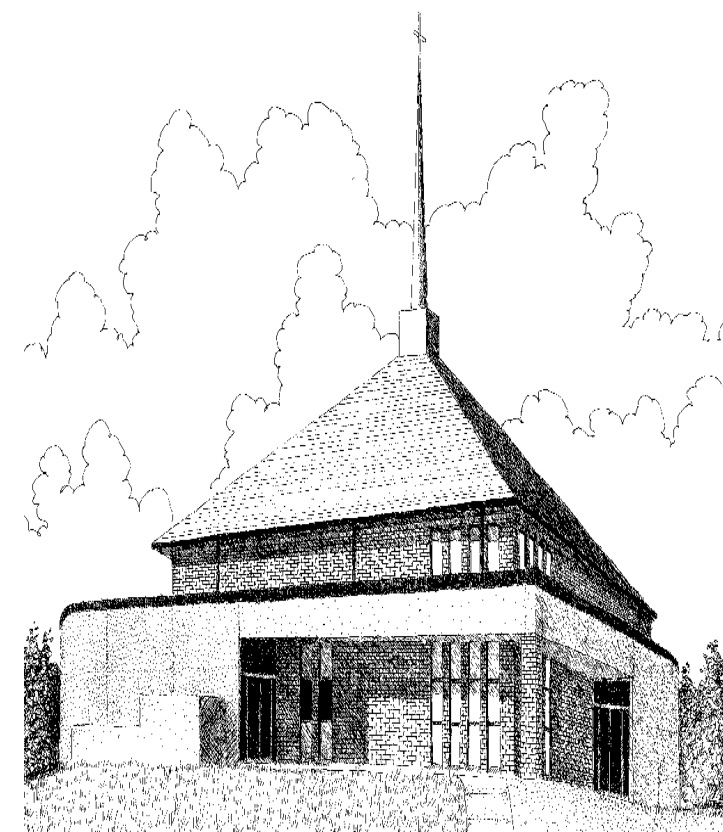
Student Awards Ceremony will be held Friday, May 22 at 10:00 am.
