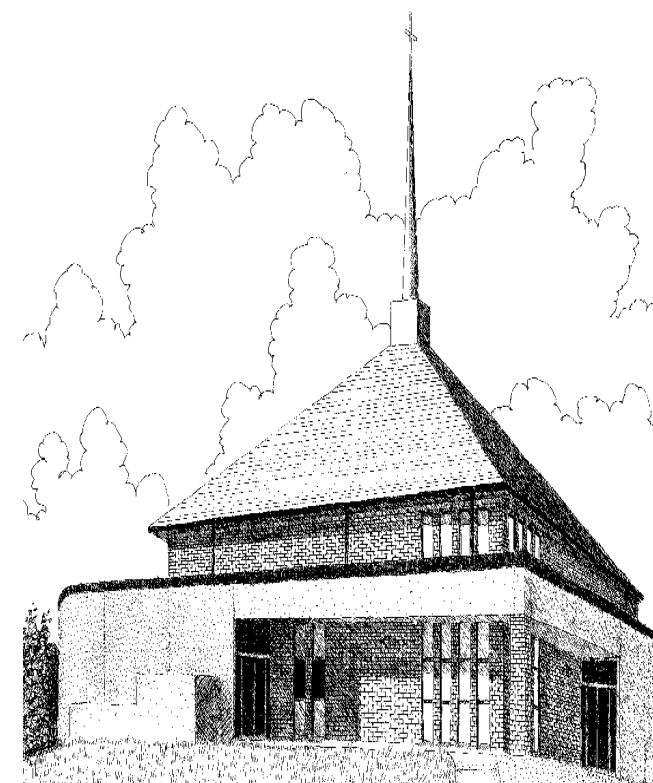
If you have questions or suggestions, your ideas and thoughts are always welcome here at ACA. We want to hear from you! My door is always open and we as a staff are excited to hear from you!
