Please be reminded that snow make up days are as follows: Thursday, Feb. 4th Monday, Feb. 15th and 1/2 day on Good Friday April 2nd.

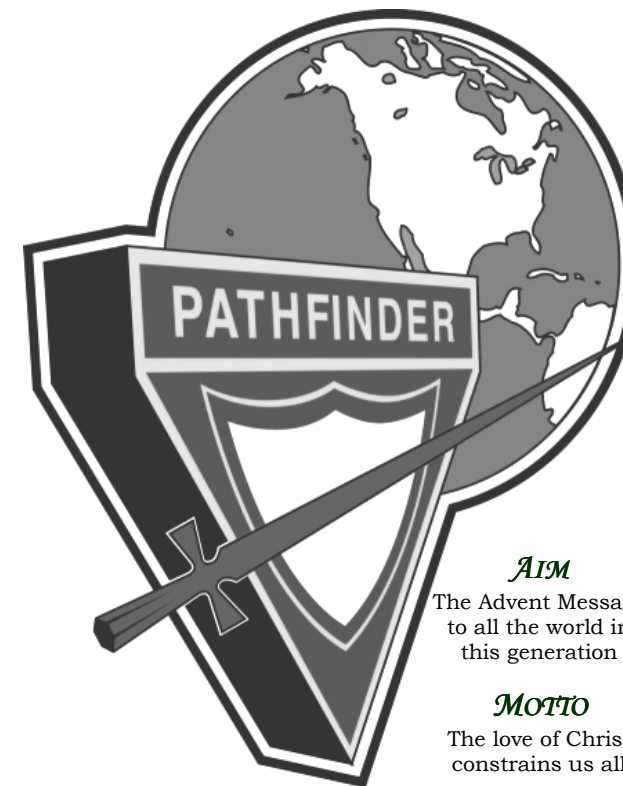
