**7th and 8th grade Graduation trip** to Washington, DC is **May 4, 5 and return on the 6th.**

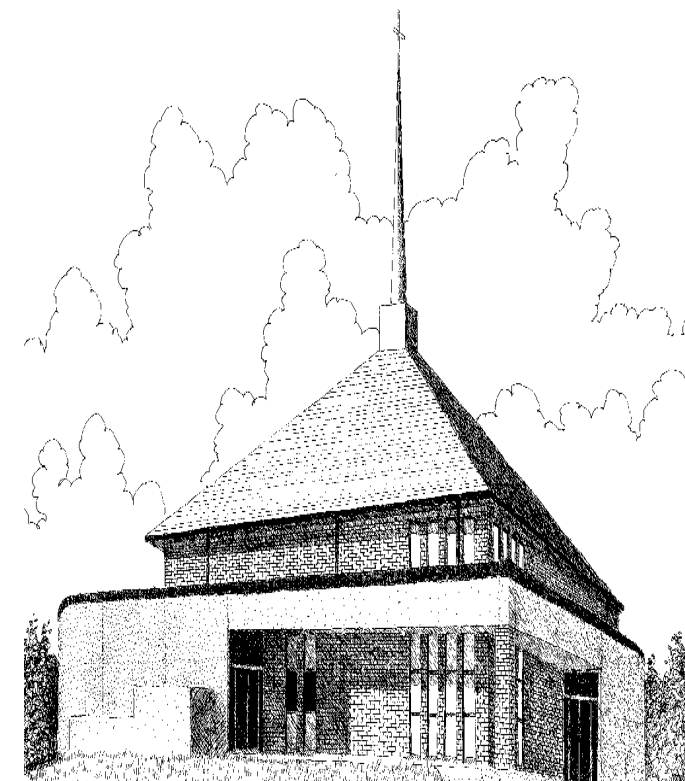
