Thanks to **Mindy Stockford** for heading up the cookie dough program!!! Thanks to all who participated in purchasing cookie dough during our fundraiser!!

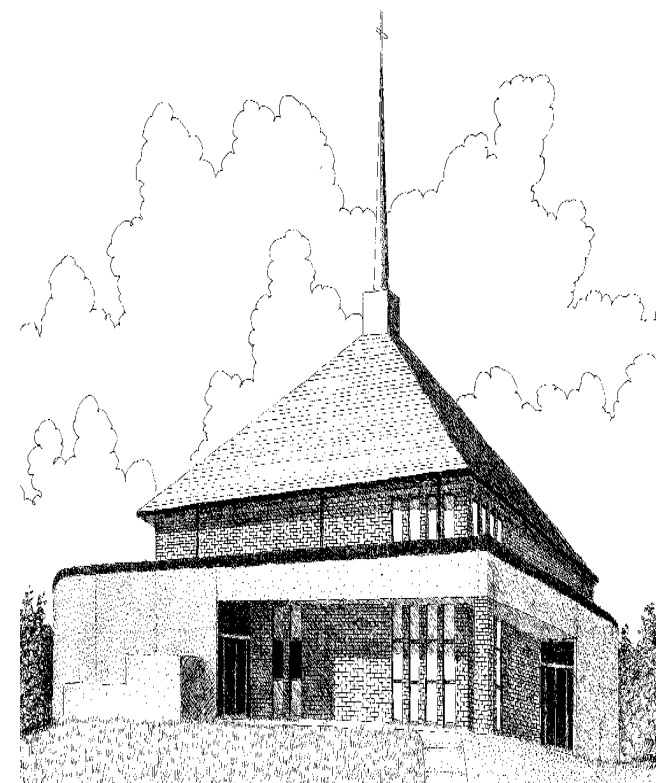

Income	\$29,582.49	\$275,329.94
Expense	\$27,174.87	\$344,405.39
Tithe	\$43,926.69	\$413,388.80

"The Church Budget is based on 60% of our annual Tithe. We are suggesting that for every dollar you pay in tithe, give 60 cents to Church Budget so we can reach our goal.
