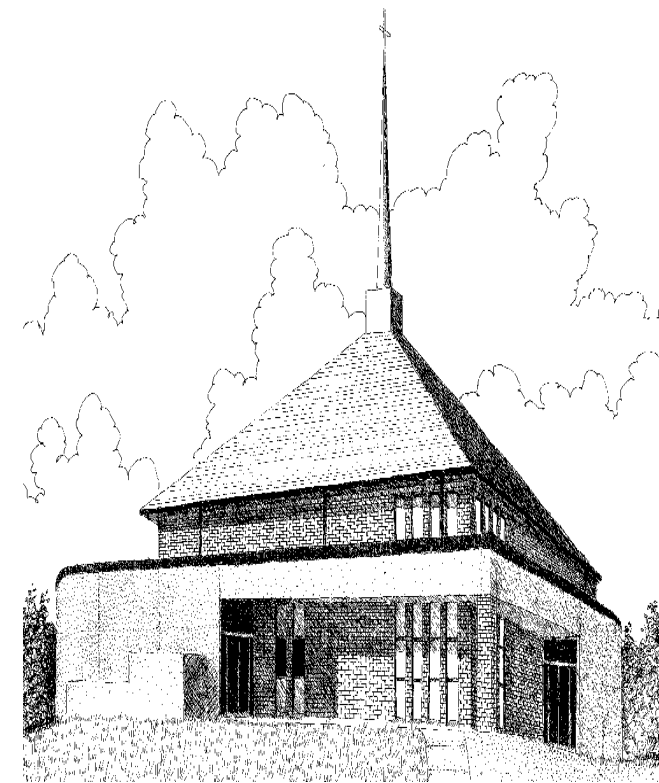

Expense	\$34,173.05	\$378,578.44
Tithe	\$37,074.61	\$450,463.41

"The Church Budget is based on 60% of our annual Tithe. We are suggesting that for every dollar you pay in tithe, give 60 cents to Church Budget so we can reach our goal.
