International Fair will be held **March 13** in the gym from 1:00 pm - 4:00 pm. Make your plans now to participate with us in this multicultural event!

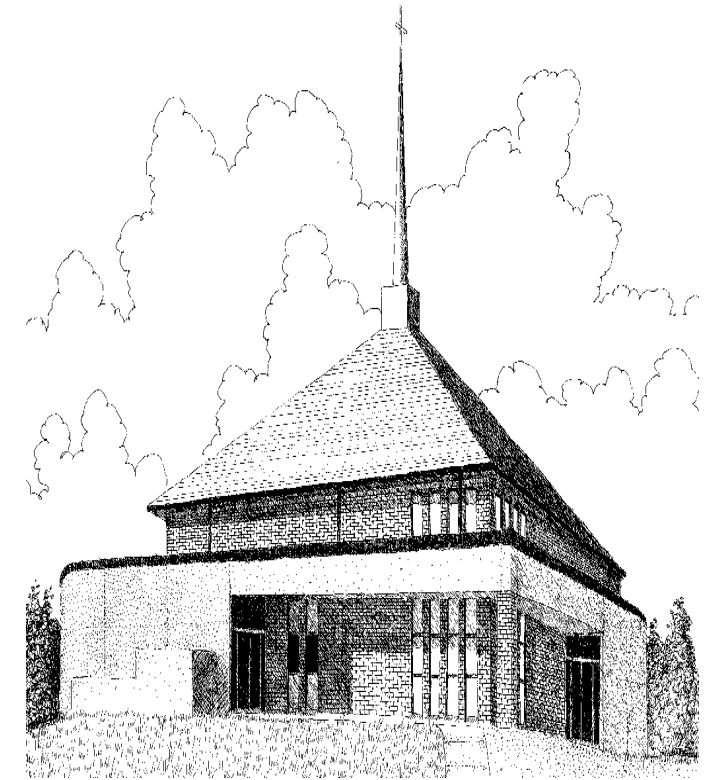
