Music Festival is March 31 through April 1. Parents will receive a letter upon student return from Spring Break.

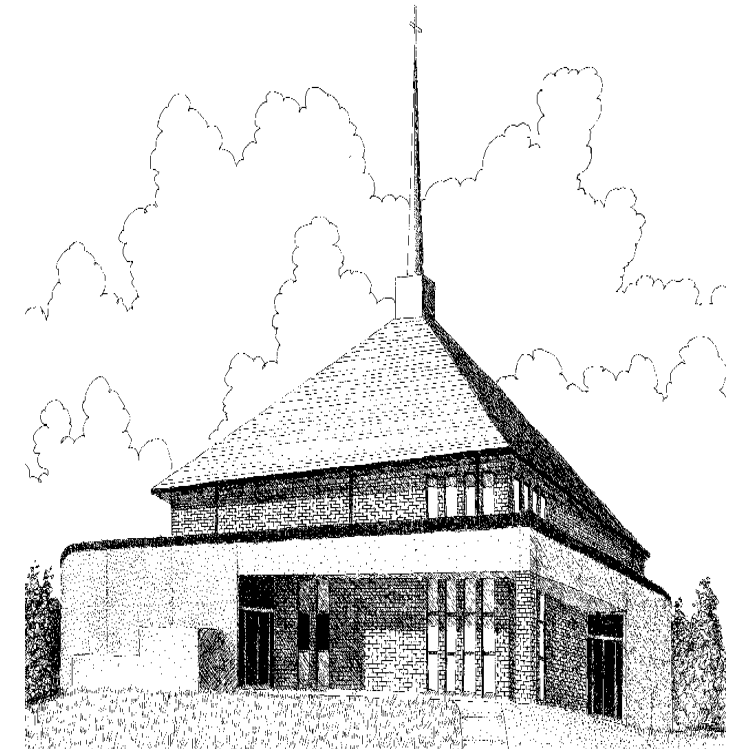
If there are no more snow days, our Easter break will be April 21, April 22 and April 25. Spring is almost here!!
