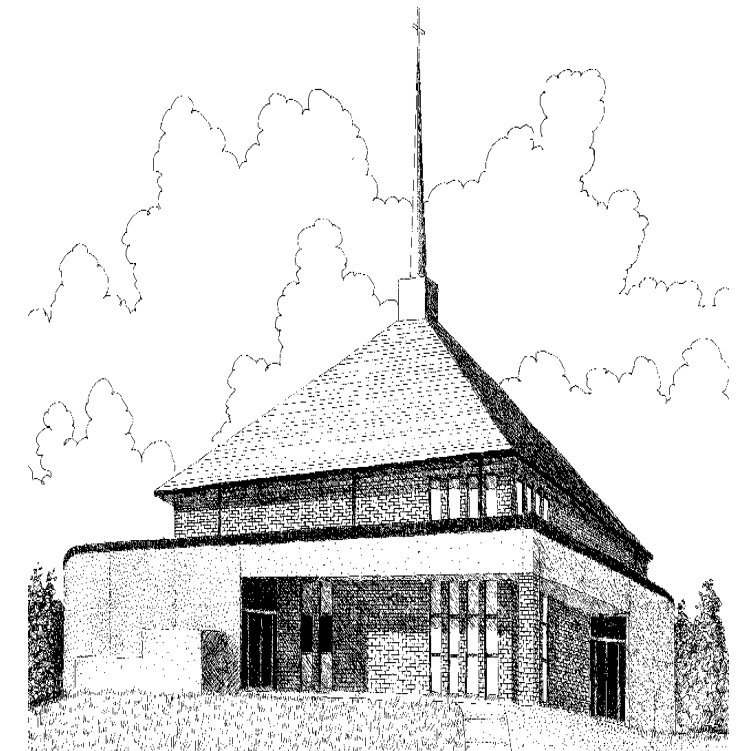

Tithe	\$29,720.49	\$93,355.11
