The Adventurer's will be going to the Nursing Home today, we will meet at the church at 3pm and going over together.

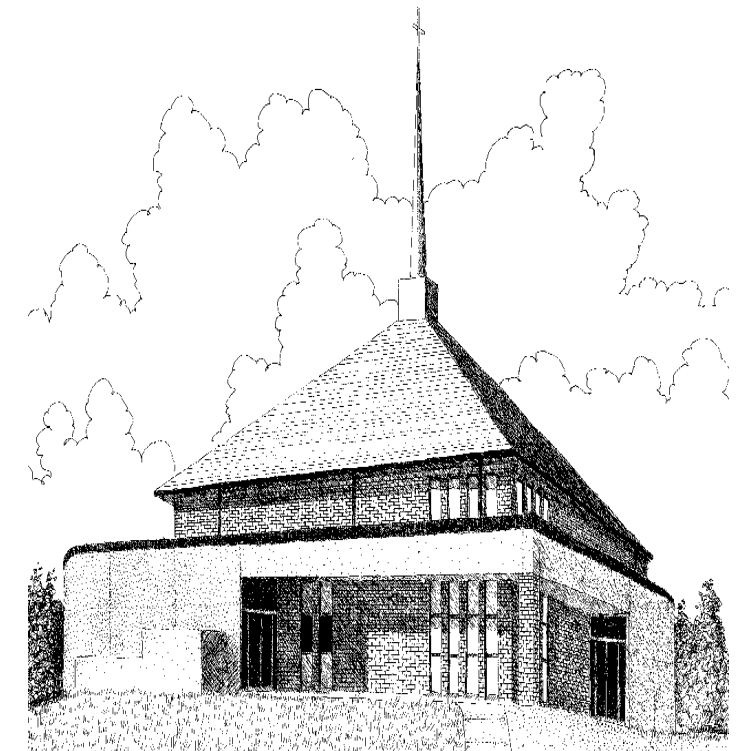
